Through our annual Fast Pitch competition, we provide access to capital, visibility, and mentoring for female founders. Our Startup Fundamentals webinars and community networking events offer valuable resources and connection opportunities for female founders.

We hope to inspire the next generation of women investors through our Due Diligence Analyst program for university women and our Junior Venture Capitalist program for girls in grades 9-12.

FEMALE FOUNDERS

Our annual Fast Pitch competition provides access to capital, visibility, pitch coaching and mentoring.

COLLEGE WOMEN

Gain real-world experience through this introduction to investing in our Due Diligence Analyst Program.

Students are paired with investor mentors and learn about performing due diligence on startups by conducting guided research on our Fast Pitch finalist companies.

Students present their reports to our Fast Pitch judges and Junior VCs.

FEMALE FOUNDERS

11th Annual Fast Pitch Competition 2023

Apply April 1 – May 31 at www.WomenFoundersNetwork.org

Application Criteria:

- Founder/Co-Founder/CEO must identify as a woman or business must be majority-owned by a woman
- Company may operate in any industry, with the exception of Life Sciences, cannabis/CBD, and nonprofits
- Must have raised no more than \$750,000 in outside funding (including personal cash funds), but excluding research grants or other non-recourse, non-dilutive grants, or PPP loans
- Early-stage plans are welcome (need to show some indication of customer interest, such as customer sign-ups, LOI's, etc.)
- Must attend the annual Fast Pitch Event in October in person
- Business must be based in the United States





UNIVERSITY WOMEN

Due Diligence Analyst Program Apply March 1 – April 30 at www.WomenFoundersNetwork.org

Application Criteria:

- Applicant must identify as a woman and be enrolled at a college or university for the 2023-2024 academic year
- There is no fee to apply
- The program will run from June through October 2022
- Each team of analysts and their mentor will be assigned a WFN Fast Pitch finalist company to analyze for its investment potential and prepare a due diligence report which they will present to the Junior Venture Capitalists and Fast Pitch Judges





JUNIOR VENTURE CAPITALIST PROGRAM

Young women in grades 9-12 are invited to apply Apply March 1 – April 30 at www.WomenFoundersNetwork.org

Since 2014, the Junior Judge program has educated more than 120 young women about entrepreneurship and investing through event outings to meet with women business leaders, interactive online assignments, workshops teaching the fundamentals of business, and their participation in the annual Women Founders Network Fast Pitch Event as "venture capitalists for a day" to vote for their favorite company and present a sponsored cash award to their winner.

The Junior VCs walk away from the experience feeling confident, inspired, and motivated, knowing there is a strong community of women available to support them in achieving their goals.
